All prize money is to be returned 100%. Prize ratio is 1/10.

This tournament is open to any member of the 700 club chapters in the upper Eastern Region of the 700 Bowling Clubs of America. Each bowler must be sanctioned in the USBC for the 2019-2020 season. Order of tournament locations is as follows: Thousand Islands 2020, Rome 2021 and Snowbelt 2022

Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will be USBC sanctioned and abide by all USC Tournament rules/regulations.
2. This tournament is open to any member of the 700 club chapters in the Eastern Region of the 700 Bowling Clubs of America.
3. All bowlers must use their highest USBC sanctioned average from the 2018-2019 season with a minimum of 21 games or more to qualify for the appropriate average group to be considered for the singles prize list. If a bowler has a USBC certified average of 10 pins or more for the 2019-2020 season as of 10/05/19, they must use that average. Any bowler not having a certified average must then bowl in the 200 and over singles division in order to cash in the singles.
4. Bowling will consist of three games in the following average divisions: 1) 200 average and above; 2) 190-199; 3) 180-189; 4) 179 and under; and 5) Granddaddy Division for bowlers 55 years of age and older. Team scores will be done for chapter by taking the top four singles and making them team 1; team 2 will consist of the next four high singles, etc...
5. This is a scratch event, except for the bowlers in the Granddaddy Division who will receive 1 pin of handicap for each year over 55.
6. Entries close on October 5, 2019 unless tournament is filled sooner.
7. Lanes will be assigned at sign in on 10/05/19.
8. Ties will be broken by the high single score.
9. Awards and prize money will be distributed for both team and singles events in the following manner: 1) Team Event: a plaque will be awarded to the winning chapter with bowlers names on it for first place; 2) Singles Event: Prize money will be distributed as per rule #8. Prizes are based on the number of entries received in each division.
10. Granddaddy Division: Everyone aged 55 and older will automatically be placed in the Granddaddy Division, receiving 1 pin of handicap per game for every year over the age of 55. If a bowler does not want to bowl in this division, they must state so prior to the start of bowling.
